



## Mid Year Average Tilapia and Catfish Price Trends: January–June 2025

### Price Movement

Between January and June 2025, the average farm gate prices for Ghana’s two most popular cultured fish species demonstrated consistent growth:

- **Tilapia: GHS 42.58 → GHS 43.27 per kg (+1.6%)**
- **Catfish: GHS 38.86 → GHS 40.28 per kg (+3.6%)**

Tilapia prices peaked in June, while Catfish prices levelled off from May after an earlier rise.

### Drivers of Stability and Growth

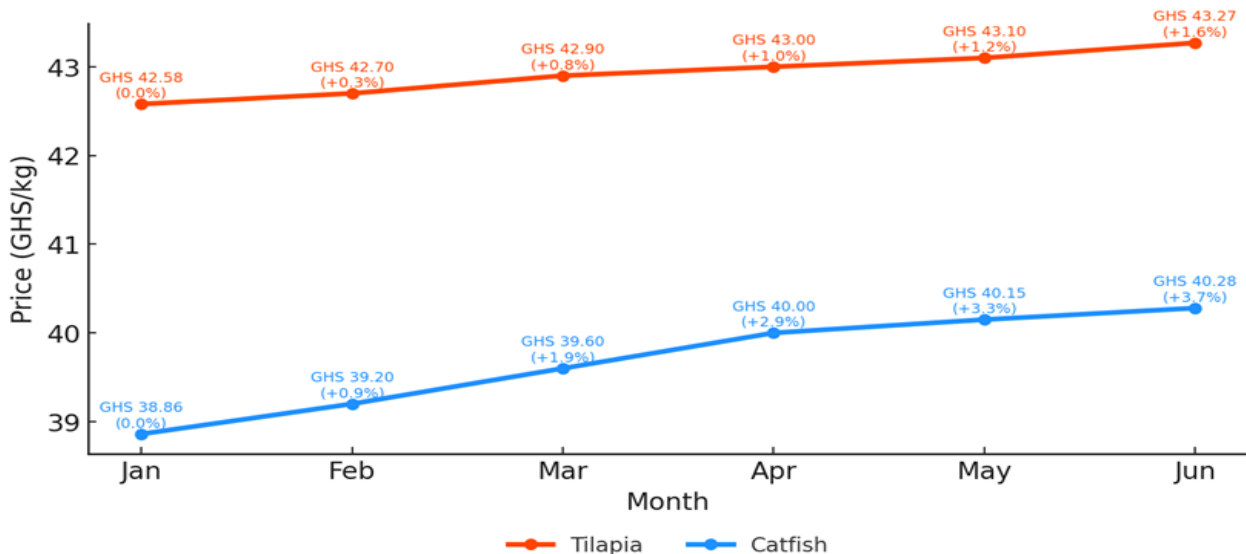
- Relatively stable feed prices have contributed largely to the minimal fluctuation in production cost.
- Decreasing inflation has enhanced market predictability.
- The strengthening of the Ghana cedi has reduced the expenses associated with imported inputs.
- Increased demand during festive periods such as Easter and Eid has resulted in temporary price surges.

### Outlook for the Rest of 2025

If the current market and economic conditions persist, the prices for Tilapia and Catfish are expected to **stay fairly stable**, which benefits both producers and consumers.

The Chamber of Aquaculture Ghana will keep monitoring price trends and update stakeholders to support informed decision-making.
